

ENROLLMENT FACTS

- All students are enrolled in HVM via a public lottery with the exception of kindergarten-age siblings of currently enrolled students.
- The majority of newly enrolled students will be 5-year-olds entering kindergarten.
- General enrollment offers are made in the early spring for the following year. Then, as space becomes available throughout the school year, additional enrollment offers will be made (this occurs in situations such as a family moving out of the area, student/program mismatch, etc.)
- Waitlists are carried from one year to the next. Students remain on the waitlist until offered admission or until they request to be removed from the list.
- Once a student has a slot in the school, the student remains a student, passing from year to year, unless he/she withdraws from the school or moves out of state.
- Once an applicant declines enrollment either before or during a school year, the applicant is removed from the waitlist. To get back on the waitlist, the student must be re-lottered.
- Enrollment is open to all MA residents with preference given to siblings of currently enrolled students and then Haverhill residents.
