

HVM – CP Scrip Program

The Scrip program is a new fundraiser for HVM - CP! This is a program that has been very successful in other schools and organizations across the country. Here's how it works:

What is Scrip? *“Scrip” is another term for money. When you participate in a Scrip Program, you purchase gift cards/certificates to stores or vendors that you would regularly shop. These stores/vendors may include your grocery store, restaurants, clothing stores, movie theaters and gas stations... just to name a few. These are the same cards that you would purchase if you went directly to the store, so these are also great for gift-giving! There are hundreds of participating vendors.*

How does HVM - CP benefit from a Scrip Program? *For every gift card purchased from our Scrip vendor, our school will earn a percentage of that card. As parents/caregivers, we can support the school without spending any additional money.*

What's in it for the Vendors? *The vendors provide the gift cards at a discount and in return they get to support a charity, advertise, sell their gift cards in bulk and obtain customer loyalty.*

How to order? *Each month we will be taking orders and will place one large order for the entire school. The orders will be filled and delivered within a two week period. You will need to include a check made out to “HVM-CP” for the cost of your entire order.*

You can use the order form listed on this site. Print out and simply check off the item you want—making sure to note amount of card—and send a check for your entire order back in to school. There will be a deadline date every month that we will be ordering by. Any orders received after that will be put towards the next month's order. After the cards come in, they will be sent back to you. Turnaround time from deadline date to receiving your cards should be approximately 10 days.

This is an administratively time intensive project that we are undertaking but we feel the possible rewards will be great. Romy Gaiero and Stephen Boyle will be administering the program at this time. We will be starting somewhat small and grow as we learn to better manage the program.
